Changes in management responsibility among members of the company are covered by this requirement. You must attach supporting documentation describing in detail the nature of such changes and the declaration must be sworn in writing and is executed under penalty of perjury of the laws of the United States.

Certification Anniversary Date: August 2, 2016 Each Year. It is also your responsibility to annually submit a No Change Affidavit and the firm's most recent business taxes to DelDOT. The No Change Affidavit is available on the DBE Program website [www.dbe.deldot.gov](http://www.dbe.deldot.gov). These documents are to be submitted to DelDOT every year on the certification anniversary date and shall specifically state that the firm

continues to meet business size criteria and the overall gross receipts cap. Any firm that fails to provide any of the aforementioned in a timely manner will be deemed to have failed to cooperate under §26.109(c) and is subject to immediate disqualification from the DBE Program. The DBE Program reserves the right to rescind certification if any information upon which it is based proves to be false, inaccurate, or misleading.
