The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) is pleased to announce that your firms certification as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) in Nevada, under the Nevada Unified Certification Program (NUCP) in accordance with 49 CFR Part 26 was renewed and is effective until July 13, 2017. Your certification number is NV20011417NUCP, your firm is certified in Construction/Project Management, Project Controls, Office Engineering, Residential Engineering, Inspection & CADD Support and is classified under the NAICS of: NAICS-541330: ENGINEERING SERVICES
NAICS-541611: ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT AND GENERAL MANAGEMENT CONSULTING SERVICES.

Your firm will be listed in Nevada's Certified Vendors Directory which can be accessed via the internet at www.nevadadbe.com. As long as the firm is listed, it is considered DBE/SBE certified by all NUCP members from the Airport Authorities of Clark and Washoe counties, the Regional Transportation Commissions (RTC) of Clark and Washoe counties, Carson City Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) and NDOT.

DBE/SBE certification is continuous but is contingent upon the firm renewing its eligibility annually through this office. You will be notified in advance of your obligation to continue eligibility by submitting a No Change Affidavit (NCA). Failure to submit forms and/or change of information will be deemed a failure to cooperate under Section 26.109 of the Regulations and may result in your firm being decertified.

DBE/SBE certification is NOT a guarantee of work, but enables your firm to compete for, and perform, contract work as a DBE contractor, subcontractor, consultant, sub-consultant or material supplier on all USDOT Federal Aid (FAA, FTA and FHWA) as well as state funded projects in Nevada.

If, at any time, there is a material change in your firm, including, but not limited to, ownership, officers, directors, scope of work being performed, daily operations, affiliations with other businesses or individuals or physical location of the firm, you must notify this office in writing without delay and in no event in not more than 30 days from the change. Notification must include supporting documentation. You will receive timely instruction from this office as to how you should proceed, if necessary. Under 49 CFR Part 26.87, if NDOT or another party challenges the eligibility of your organization you will be notified in writing and given the opportunity to present your arguments against removal in an informal hearing. If after this hearing your certification is removed, you will have the opportunity to appeal that decision to the U.S. Department of Transportation.

NDOT reserves the right to withdraw this certification if at any time it is determined that it was knowingly obtained by false, misleading, or incorrect information. DBE/SBE certification is subject to

review at any time. Your firm hereby consents to the examination of its books, records and documents by NDOT.
